POSTER PRESENTATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Poster Session and Poster Contest of ICFF VIII will be held in Guangzhou, China on 6 January 2008. According to the Abstract ID No., each abstract will be allocated with a white board to be exhibited by a **self-prepared** poster. A poster presentation author **SHOULD** either ask organizers of ICFF VIII to mount the poster for him/her by delivering the poster to the conference organizer at the registration desk **from 8:00am to 1:30pm on 6 January 2008** or do it by him/her-self **between 2:30pm and 3:00pm on 6 January**. Necessary mounting tools will be provided then. On or after 20 December 2007, the **Poster Allocation Map** can be downloaded on the conference website: <http://www.me.ust.hk/~icff8>.

Awards

During the poster session, One first, two second and three third **Best Poster Awards** will be generated from the poster contest. A certificate and an award will be bestowed on each award winner on the ICFF VIII banquet held on 7 January 2008.

Poster Preparation

1. A poster should be self printed to one A0 size paper, 841mm(W)×1189mm(H) or equivalent.
2. The language in poster presentation should be English.
3. A readable, sufficiently large font, i.e. minimum 28pt of Arial for the text, should be adopted.
4. A poster should at least include the poster title, name and affiliation of author(s), phone, fax and E-mail address of the corresponding author, and the contents of the research work.
5. The percentage of the text, figures and empty space in a poster should be appropriately arranged.

Remarks

Poster presentations are interactive. The presentation author of a poster is encouraged to stay beside his/her poster to ready to explain the details of the research work.
